**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST
NATIONAL CONSULTANT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF SYSTEM CERTIFICATION SCHEMES FOR RICE
(REF.: TDSP/2011/068/9)**

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing in the amount of US\$ 12.60 million, from the Multi Donor Trust Fund (MDTF) for the Trade Development Support Program (TDSP) administered by the World Bank, and contributed to by the European Commission, DANIDA and UNIDO. The Ministry of Commerce (MOC), through the Department of International Cooperation (DICO), is the implementing agency responsible for managing the overall implementation of the TDSP and coordination with other line ministries and stakeholders. The MOC will apply part of the proceeds of the Trust Fund to payments for goods, works, and consulting services to be procured under the program.
2. The Institute of Standards of Cambodia (ISC) is authorized as the National Standards and Conformity Assessment Body of Cambodia. Within its mandate it provides oversights and the following services as its key businesses: (a) assessment of specific needs in the field of standards formulation processes, (b) training and consultancy services, (c) product certification processes, (d) systems certification processes (e) library and information services on technology, market requirements, technical requirements and other requirements that may pose a technical barrier to trade.
3. DICO, serving as the Project Coordination Unit, on behalf of the ISC, is recruiting an **National Consultant for Development of System Certification Schemes for Rice**. The objective of the assignment is to coordinate with the international consultant to develop the systems certification scheme for Rice. The Consultant duties and responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:
 - Conduct survey and collect all relevant information at specified provinces
 - Cooperate with International consultant and CCD-ISC to develop the necessary documents for certification scheme in compliance with international requirements for rice export;
 - Develop and update existing food safety certification scheme based on the International Consultant's action plan to meet international requirements;
 - Develop necessary documents for certification scheme in compliance with international requirements for rice export;
 - Complete the developed document after reviewing by International Consultant and CCD-ISC;
 - Translation service from English to Khmer and vice versa.
 - Cooperate with International Consultant to conduct trainings to rice millers and other stakeholders
 - Prepare documents to assist CCD-ISC for applying identified accreditation;
4. The services will be contracted for 8 months over the period of 10 months.

5. DICO invites expressions of interest from qualified and experienced individual consultants to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detailed in the Terms of Reference for this assignment. The successful consultant will be selected in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, May 2004, revised October 2006.
6. In submitting their expressions of interest, consultants are kindly requested to indicate the following reference (Ref: TDSP/2010/068/9). Interested consultants must provide their updated curriculum vitae, indicating personal and technical skills, academic qualifications, experience in similar assignments, and experience in Cambodia and/or other developing countries along with the names of at least three (3) referees with contact information (e-mail address, telephone or fax numbers). Expressions of Interest may be submitted electronically followed by the submission of a hard copy as well. If it is submitted in hard copy, consultants must also provide an electronic copy.
