FOR NATIONAL IT CONSULTANT TO UPGRADE AND MAINTAIN GDCE WEBSITE**

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing in the amount of US\$ 12.60 million, from the Multi Donor Trust Fund (MDTF) for the Trade Development Support Program (TDSP) administered by the World Bank, and contributed to by the European Commission, DANIDA and UNIDO. The Ministry of Commerce (MOC), through the Department of International Cooperation (DICO), is the implementing agency responsible for managing the overall implementation of the TDSP and coordination with other line ministries and stakeholders. The MOC will apply part of the proceeds of the Trust Fund to payments for goods, works, and consulting services to be procured under the program.
2. DICO, serving as the Project Coordination Unit, on behalf of the General Department of Customs and Excise (GDCE), is recruiting a **National IT Consultant to Upgrade and Maintain the GDCE Website**. The GDCE has developed a homepage (website) for the dissemination of customs and trade related information to traders. The address of the website is www.customs.gov.kh. This website is operational but it lacks regular updates and requires redesign to make it more professional and current in terms of the interface, view and contents.
3. The selected National IT Consultant will be responsible for re-designing or re-developing, upgrading/ updating and hosting the GDCE website
4. The position is full time for a period of 10 months or through to 31st January 2014.
5. DICO invites expressions of interest from qualified and experienced individual consultants to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detailed in the Terms of Reference for this assignment. The successful consultant will be selected in accordance with the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011.
6. In submitting their expressions of interest, consultants are kindly requested to indicate the following reference (Ref:TDSP/2012/078/04). Interested consultants must provide their updated curriculum vitae, indicating personal and technical skills, academic qualifications, experience in similar assignments, and experience in Cambodia and/or other developing countries along with the names of at least three (3) referees with contact information (e-mail address, telephone or fax numbers). Expressions of Interest may be submitted electronically followed by the submission of a hard copy as well. If it is submitted in hard copy, consultants must also provide an electronic copy.
