REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST
FOR INTERNATIONAL CONSULTANT ON SAFEGUARD INVESTIGATION
(REF. TDSP/2014/099)

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing in the amount of approximately US\$ 15.45 million equivalent, from the Multi Donor Trust Fund, contributed by the European Commission, DANIDA and UNIDO. The fund will be managed by the World Bank as “trustee” to support the “Trade Development Support Program (TDSP)” with the Department of International Cooperation (DICO) of the Ministry of Commerce as the Executing Agency in coordination with other line ministries and stakeholders. The Ministry intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project.
2. The Trade SWAp combines the activities of many individual donors within three separate pillars: Pillar 1 for cross-cutting reforms, Pillar 2 for sectorial initiatives and Pillar 3 for capacity building. Many activities that take place within the trade SWAp overlap with each other and therefore the division between pillars is sometimes arbitrary. Guidelines have been put together by the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) to organize the various activities taking place in each of the three Pillars of the Trade SWAp, which guidelines are referred to as the Pillar Roadmaps.
3. The DICO, serving as Secretariat to the TDSP, is recruiting an **International Consultant on Safeguard** who will be working under Department of Notifications and Legal Compliance (D/NLC) of the Ministry of Commerce, in his role the **International Consultant on Safeguard** to compile and draft a manual on procedures to be followed in undertaking a safeguards investigation, conduct a series of workshops for the RGC’s Trade Remedies Team designed to familiarize team members with the usual content of such procedures manuals, and to receive guidance from the team on the desired scope and level of detail of the manual and provide training on the use of the manual, and to participate in a workshop introducing Cambodia’s trade remedies legislation to the private sector. The position of **International Consultant on Safeguard** require a person of particular experience, integrity and knowledge:
 - Master’s degree in law or business.
 - Minimum 5 years’ experience in conducting safeguards investigations.
 - Experience in providing training on investigation procedures is a plus.
 - Experience working in any trade-related projects of the Asian Development Bank or the World Bank for a minimum period of at least 5 years.
 - Good Inter-personal skill.

- Fluency in written and spoken English.
4. The **International Consultant on Safeguard** is expected to conduct the assigned tasks over the **period of 30 days**, of which only **25 days of DSA** will be given since there are some tasks to be completed as home-based.
 5. DICO invites expressions of interest from qualified and experienced individual candidates to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detailed in the Terms of Reference for this assignment. The successful candidate will be selected in accordance with the provisions of Section II, under the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011.
 6. In submitting their expressions of interest, candidates are kindly requested to indicate the following reference (Ref. TDSP/2014/099). Interested candidates must provide their updated curriculum vitae, indicating personal and technical skills, academic qualifications, experience in similar assignments, and experience in Cambodia and/or other developing countries along with the names of at least three (3) referees with contact information (e-mail address, telephone or fax numbers). Expressions of Interest may be submitted electronically followed by the submission of a hard copy as well. If it is submitted in hard copy, candidates must also provide an electronic copy.
 7. Candidates may obtain copies of the detailed Terms of Reference (in English) for the assignment from the address below during office hours from 7:30 to 11:30 and from 14:00 to 17:30 hours, Monday through Friday.
