**FOR INTERNATIONAL EDITOR (INDIVIDUAL)**  
**(INTERMITTENT)**  
**(REF. TDSP/2014/105)**

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing in the amount of approximately US\$ 15.45 million equivalent, from the Multi Donor Trust Fund, contributed by the European Commission, DANIDA and UNIDO. The fund will be managed by the World Bank as “trustee” to support the “Trade Development Support Program (TDSP)” with the Department of International Cooperation (DICO) of the Ministry of Commerce as the Executing Agency in coordination with other line ministries and stakeholders. The Ministry intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project.
2. The Trade SWAp combines the activities of many individual donors within three separate pillars: Pillar 1 for cross-cutting reforms, Pillar 2 for sectorial initiatives and Pillar 3 for capacity building. Many activities that take place within the trade SWAp overlap with each other and therefore the division between pillars is sometimes arbitrary. Guidelines have been put together by the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) to organize the various activities taking place in each of the three Pillars of the Trade SWAp, which guidelines are referred to as the Pillar Roadmaps.
3. The DICO, serving as Secretariat to the TDSP, is recruiting an **International Editor** who will be working under the DICO at the Ministry of Commerce. The **International Editor** must i) develop an online virtual network with information on the Agreement and its implementation, to serve as a central, collaborative hub for officials of TDSP and implementation institutions and the Trade SWAp ii) organize and facilitate a training session for focal points on areas of strategic communications and media relations and iii) assist DICO and the TDSP implementation agencies with the development and strengthening of national communications plans/strategies for the Program and the Trade SWAp.
4. The positions of **International Editor** requires a person of particular experience, integrity and knowledge:
  - Master Degree in Communications, Media Management, Development Communications, and/or Journalism.
  - At least 3 years of relevant professional work experience at the national or international level;

- Sound liaison, negotiation and representational skills in local and national levels;
  - Proven experience in developing and/or implementing communication strategies in the context of multi stakeholders engagement with incorporation of capacity development;
  - Sound knowledge in trade development, trade mainstreaming, public sector management and reform issues in developing countries will be an advantage;
  - Interest in and commitment to coaching;
  - Experience working in multi-donor and multi-stakeholder environment; experience working with the government, or in Asian LDC would be an advantage; and
  - Computer literate (MS office, Excel, PowerPoint, other.)
  - Proficiency in written and spoken English.
5. **The International Editor** will be contracted for **60 working days** from contract signing date up to 31 March 2015.
  6. DICO invites expressions of interest from qualified and experienced individual candidates to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detailed in the Terms of Reference for this assignment. The successful candidate will be selected in accordance with the provisions of Section V, under the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011.
  7. In submitting their expressions of interest, candidates are kindly requested to indicate the following reference (Ref. TDSP/2014/105). Interested candidates must provide their updated curriculum vitae, indicating personal and technical skills, academic qualifications, experience in similar assignments, and experience in Cambodia and/or other developing countries along with the names of at least three (3) referees with contact information (e-mail address, telephone or fax numbers). Expressions of Interest may be submitted electronically followed by the submission of a hard copy as well. If it is submitted in hard copy, candidates must also provide an electronic copy.
