1. The Kingdom of Cambodia has received financing in the amount of US\$ 12.35 million, from the Multi Donor Trust Fund for the Trade Development Support Program (TDSP) (“the Trust Fund”) administered by the World Bank, and contributed to by the European Commission, DANIDA and UNIDO. The development objective of the Project is to support the Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC)’s strategy to promote Trade Sector Wide Approach (Trade SWAp).
2. The Ministry of Commerce (MOC), through the Department of International Cooperation (DICO), is the implementing agency responsible for managing the overall implementation of the TDSP and coordination with other line ministries and stakeholders. The MOC will apply part of the proceeds of the Trust Fund to payments for goods, works, and consulting services to be procured under the program.
3. The DICO, serving as the Project Coordination Unit, is responsible for managing and coordinating the project works in procurement, finance, monitoring and evaluation, is required to be in constant communication with the World Bank, key stakeholders and implementing agencies. In order to facilitate the implementation of the TDSP, the DICO wishes to recruit an **International Individual Consultant training on SOClass Development** who will be work at General Department of Customs and Excise has already deployed customs automated system using ASYCUDA World (AW), which was developed by UNCTAD as modules of SOClass e-Document Server, in accordance with the World Bank procedures and guidelines. The services to be provided will include, but are not limited to: training is designed to be imparted to IT technical members of the National Project Team. Duration of the training programme will be 10 working days. Furthermore, training programme should ensure achievements of the objectives (as in TOR) setting and training would be delivered through hands-on and interactive discussions or any other approaches where appropriate in English.

The trainer will be expected to possess substantial qualification on SOClass development as following:

- At least bachelor degree in computer science or IT related subject.
- Minimum 3 years programming experience and knowledge on SOClass range of products particularly SOClass e-Document Server and SOClass Development.
- Knowledge in ASYCUDA World development is a plus.
- Knowledge in Oracle Database is also preferred.
- Knowledge in Web Development is advantage

4. DICO invites expressions of interest from qualified and experienced individual consultants to undertake the above mentioned services which are further detailed in the Terms of Reference for this assignment. The successful consultant will be selected in accordance with the provisions of Section II, under the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011.
5. In submitting their expressions of interest, consultants are kindly requested to indicate the following reference (TDSP/2012/078/07/2). Interested consultants must provide their updated curriculum vitae, indicating personal and technical skills, academic qualifications, experience in similar assignments, and experience in Cambodia and/or other developing countries along with the names of at least three (3) referees with contact information (e-mail address, telephone or fax numbers). Expressions of Interest may be submitted electronically followed by the submission of a hard copy as well. If it is submitted in hard copy, consultants must also provide an electronic copy.
