Improving SSC-TD-TRI efficiency

Rationale

- ✓ New CTIS 2014-2018 and accompanying SWAp roadmaps
- ✓ New Government term and SSC composition and reforms
- ✓ Lessons learnt from the past 5 years:
 - Low interaction but still long meetings
 - Fewer private sector participation
 - Overall focus on project
 - No new DP engaged

Track 1: IC reporting

Purpose:

- ✓ Elevate IC decisions at SSC level for approval

Process:

- DICO (IC Secretariat) to present conclusions and recommendations of IC meetings.
- SSC to endorse/reject/ask for further work.

Track 2: SWAp Progress Monitoring

Purpose: track progress realized in CTIS implementation and progress towards SWAp goals and identify key gaps

Process:

- IC Chair to update on status, linking SWAp implementation to budget being allocated to projects and disbursed;
- Development partners to update on additional/new initiatives (possibly from PSD TWG meetings);
- Use dashboard / database, to be maintained up-to-date by DICO.

Track 3: Focused Dialogue

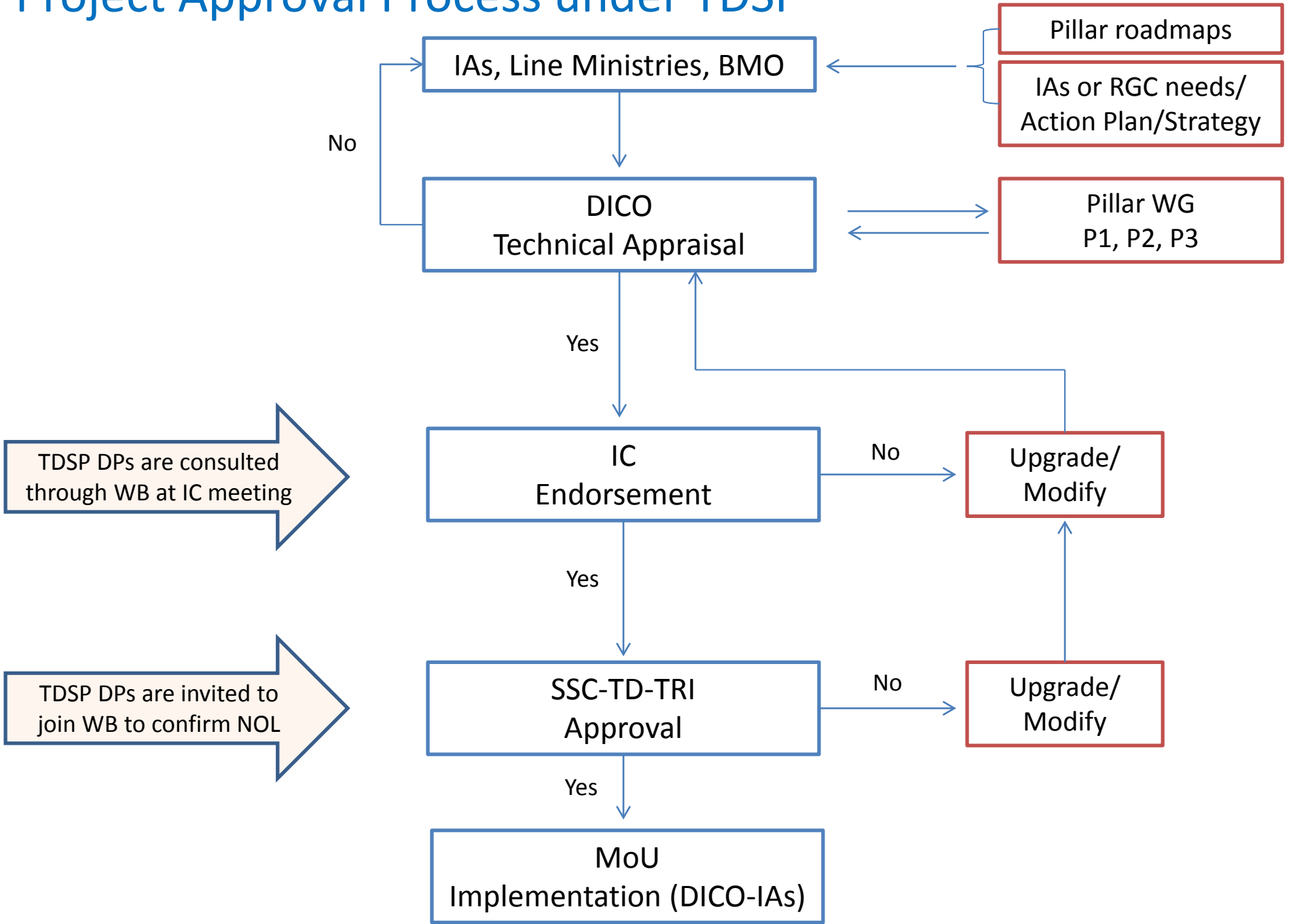
Purpose:

Track progress in individual reform areas and address issues

Process:

- Pick one or two CTIS Outcomes for each SSC meeting and invite Govt officials, private sector reps and DPs to report on progress being made in those areas against some of the targets set out in the Roadmap,
- Take decisions on further actions,
- Seek additional assistance.
