Three focal sectors for the period 2014-2020

FOCAL SECTORS	MIP 2014-2020	%
1. Agriculture/Natural resource management (Fisheries & Forestry)	EUR 144 million	35%
2. Education/Skills	EUR 140 million	34%
3. Governance and Administration	EUR 120 million	29%
Support measures	EUR 6 million	2%
TOTAL	EUR 410 million	100%



Agriculture / NRM sector:

- ✓ € 144 million: 1st tranche committed in 2016, 2nd in 2019
- ✓ Three results:
 - **Improved business enabling environment for the agriculture and NRM related sectors**, through the improvement of existing national capacities, policies and regulations which support the development of sustainable agricultural and forestry use and commercialisation, stimulate innovation and private sector investment, and ensure protection of natural resources.
 - **Strengthened value chains**, including increased productivity, processing efficiency, improved product quality and increased market competitiveness in domestic and export markets that result in increased rural incomes and employment creation.
 - **Empowered local communities to participate in the conservation and management of agriculture and natural resources including sustainable forest management (FLEGT)** through the improvement of national and sub-national capacities, regulations and law enforcement.



Programming ...

- Identification , May-June 2015
- Formulation, q4 2015
- Programmes to start by early 2017



An additional Support for Trade and Economic integration (from Multiannual Indicative Programme for ASEAN - 2014-2020).

Support the ASEAN Economic Integration beyond 2015 :

- Support improvements in customs, transit, standards, services, investment, food safety, IPR.
- Narrowing the development gaps in the public administrations of CMLVs
- Further integration into the global economy of ASEAN Member States
- Euro 50 million
- Will include regional programmes (ECAP IV, ARISE) and national envelopes (Cambodia)



Programming ...

- Identification finalised in January 2015
- Formulation ongoing (June-September)
- Tentative date for Cambodia formulation mission : 22-26th June 2015
- New programme to start q4 2016
- Exploring new modalities for implementation , building on what has been achieved, more RGC ownership.



Identification Highlights – Trade and PSD

- Government and Private Sector driven vs Donor Driven
- Pro-poor Approach = Reach the Poor and Measure Impact
- Bottom-up = Ease Access to Markets; Give Voice to Producers
- ‘Missing Middle’ = Respect and Support Middlemen and SME in VCs
- Top-down = Create Enabling Environment; Ensure Compliance
- Coordinate = Cambodian Product!
- Compete = Cost/Red Tape; Infrastructure; Skills; Quality; Finance
- Sustain = Institutionally, Socially; Environmentally, Economically
