- Reviewing Project reports (QPR, Semi-Annual & Annual reports, etc.)
- Reviewing project evaluation reports (Mid-term & final)
- Reviewing communication materials producing by different project stakeholders
- Collecting information from different sources
- Meeting with project beneficiaries and key stakeholders

Why do we need to take stock of project results, good practices and success stories?

- To show project achievements, outcomes and impact
- To analyze and produce actual figures
- To share and showcase project achievements with the relevant key stakeholders, particularly the donors and DPs
- To attract new potential donors and DPs
- To keep as a lesson learnt for the new project

What kind of document that should be developed?

- Documentation reports
- Video documentary
- Various communication materials etc.
