TDSP PROJECT APPROVAL PROCESS & EIF TIER 2 PROJECT FORMULATION UPDATE

TDSP Dec 2011 Aide-Memoire

- Item 8b: *Implementing Agencies face technical difficulties in formulating technical proposals addressing the priorities outlined in the Trade SWAp roadmaps. In future, it is recommended that the Pillars' Leaders use the completed roadmaps, providing technical experts with clear briefings for developing detailed project proposals*
- Item 9c: *The mechanism to ensure a more proactive formulation of strategic and sound project proposals on trade-related themes cutting across implementing agencies would need to be fine-tuned to achieve more effectiveness*

TDSP Project Formulation, Appraisal and Approval Process

TDSP Project Approval Process

- To be implemented for ALL project formulation under RETF
- Support from D/ICO limited to appraise proposals received from Pillar WG Team Leaders (not directly from IAs)
- D/ICO can also provide assistance to IAs Pillar Leaders, IC and SSC.TD-TRI through dedicated consultants
- Aimed to ensure RGC's ownership on project funded under TDSP

EIF TIER 2 UPDATE: CEDEP I

- ✓ Cambodia Export Diversification and Expansion Programme I (CEDEP I)
- ✓ Support to Rice export, Silk export and SWAp
M&E Function of D/ICO
- ✓ Implemented jointly by IFC, ITC, with support from MOC, MAFF, MOWA, MRD
- ✓ Preliminary estimates: US\$2.3m, 3 years, starting Q3 2012
- ✓ Submitted on Dec 11, 2012. Mission coming.



EIF TIER 2 UPDATE: CEDEP II

- Cambodia Export Diversification and Expansion Programme I (CEDEP II)
- Senior Minister, MoC requested background data on 5 focus areas: Tourism, Cassava, seafood, light manufacturing in SEZ, halal food (all under Pillar 2)
- Selection of 3 areas expected for next SSC.TD.TRI
- Potential partners: UNIDO, UNDP, MoT, MAFF, MIME, Private Sector
- Aimed at US\$3.3m project, kick off Q3 2012.
