# Background



- SWAp Pillar Roadmaps was expected to monitor on annual basis through Annual Retreats.
- The last Trade SWAp retreat was organized on 20-22 April 2010 (two-day long workshop) in SHV.
  - It was to provide up-to-date information on SWAp implementation, the corresponding mechanisms and expectations so as to define ambitious milestones for 2010.
  - Presided over by HE. Dr. Cham Prasidh, Senior Minister, Minister of Commerce and attended by around 200 participants including members of SSC, IC, Pillar WGs, and DPs and private sector.



# 2013 Trade SWAp Retreat ?



- DTIS update is being carried out by RGC to define trade integration strategy for Cambodia for next 5 years.
- NSDP and Rectangular Strategy is under updated for next government mandate.
- Many progress of SWAp has been made by various implementation agencies through TDSP, EIF, and other projects.
- The SWAp is at the crossroads of its existence, It is right time for the retreat to mobilize all stakeholder to be prepared to contribute to these developments.



# Objective of Trade SWAp Retreat



- To provide the right forum for taking stock of progress realized since its launch in early 2008, looking into ways to show results and progress towards the expected goals and strategic outcomes of its three pillars.
- To develop a vision for next five year for each pillar based on the structure of the DTIS, this will lead to review the roadmaps by focusing on main priorities and strategic objectives, and agree on building blocks to develop (2013) new (TDSP) project proposals.
- To support trade mainstreaming strategy and strengthen the engagement of private sector on AfT and SWAp design and implementation.

- Report of Progress of KPIs at goal and strategic outcomes level of each pillar.
- Draft new pillar goal and strategic outcomes for next five years.
- Strategy and Action Plan for engaging private sector and new donors to trade SWAp.

- DTIS update team will use the retreat report.
