## Results of Group Discussion of Pillar 2

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## I. Lesson Learnt and Best Practice

### 1. What factors contributed to the success of the pillar roadmaps?

- During the Roadmaps preparation was involved by various stakeholders, and especially by donors.



## 2. What are key challenges or constraints in implementing the pillar roadmaps?

- Lack of budget support
- Some of institutions have been involved in the Roadmaps preparation, but they have no project.
- Lack of commitment from working group member.
- Limited benefit for private sector.
- Some of agenda of Pillar working group meeting is not relevant to some member, So they are not interest to attend the meeting
- Limited capacity for project implementation.



### **3. How did the Pillar working groups address the challenges or constraints happen during the past few years implementation?**

- Search for alternative funding sources.
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#### **4. What are key lessons learned and good practice to be considered for future implementation on the following areas:**

##### **a. Formulation of new trade proposal:**

- If any institution have limited resources (budget & Capacity) in the proposal preparation, they should find any related agency to be associate/partner for proposal preparation
- To define what our agency can be done and what do we need more support from others.
- Learnt from TDSP implementation, TDP has used these experiences to prepare few small pilot projects (budget around 25,000 USD).

- Close monitor what have been set in the project document
- Review and feedback on the submitted report

- DTIS is Trade Policy Development for further policy development as well as an instrument for resource mobilization
- Should involve Pillar members in the process.



### 3. What are your recommendations on strengthening the role of pillar WGs and sub-working groups?

- Should updated list of member by keep only relevant member and add new member working related sector.
- Some pillar member changed the function or move to other workplace.
- Improve the coordination mechanism (close follow-up with member through phone, email, etc.) and line-ministries.
- Improve the outreach activities
- Organize a mini-retreat by invite all related stakeholder including donor and other agencies who are working on related sector (CAVAC, HARVEST/USAID....). The main agenda of the mini-retreat is to present what have been done, what remain pending activities, and what action need to be taken.
- Prepare a clear schedule for Pillar meeting
- Engage more private sector
- Involved/add the technical officer into the Pillar working group meeting



## 4. What are your recommendations to donors concerning implementing the updated roadmaps?

- Involve relevant donors into Roadmap implementation process.
- Engage more donor or project to be part of the Roadmap and complement to each other
- Strengthening the communication between government agency and donor as well as private sector.



## **5. What are your recommendations to improve relationship between private sector and Trade SWAp?**

- Engage more private sector to attend in the Pillar WG activities.

## **6. How to improve M&E of the updated roadmaps?**

- Simplify the result framework, indicator, and report format
- Pillar WG meeting should review what have been done, remain pending activities, and what action to be taken.
